

# UNRULY BEHAVIOR

WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

- The traveling public and crewmembers are entitled to a safe environment when onboard an aircraft.
- Under Federal law, no person may assault, threaten, intimidate, or interfere with crewmembers (including flight attendants) in the performance of their duties aboard an aircraft.
- Interference with any crewmember on an aircraft may result in criminal prosecution.*
- Any person who physically assaults or threatens to physically assault a crewmember or any other individual on an aircraft is subject to a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 under Federal law.
